Did You Know...

Helping Kids Succeed

- * More than 5,600 youth participated in scouting programs
- * More than 70 Big Brother and Big Sister matches to at-risk youth
- * Over 1,700 children provided with day care and before/after school programs

Increasing Independence for Seniors

- * More than 8,000 days of Adult Day Care
- * More than 66,000 congregate and home delivered hot nutritious meals provided
- * Almost 35,000 senior assurance calls
- * More than 50,000 hours of home health care visits to the elderly and ill

Strengthening Families

- * Over 19,000 hours of individual, marital, group and family therapy
- * More than 2,600 hours of bereavement counseling for families suffering a loss of a loved one
- * More than 1,800 nights of safe house shelter to families that are victims of domestic violence

Meeting Basic Needs

- * Almost 660 cases of legal aid provided
- * Almost 413,000 pounds of food distributed
- * Almost 2,600 shelter nights were provided for homeless individuals

Fostering Self-Sufficiency

- * Almost 8,000 hours of adult literacy tutoring provided
- * Almost 8,000 hours of assistance provided to individuals with developmental disabilities to learn and enjoy use of recreation time
- * More than 5,600 hours of respite care for family caregivers

Promoting Health and Wellness

- * More than 188 individuals recovering from alcohol and substance abuse were assisted through residential house services
- * Over 13,200 people provided with drug and alcohol education
- * Almost 1,000 hours of advocacy provided to increase access to services for the Latino community
