This policy outlines the guidelines and procedures for posting job opportunities on our platform.

Eligibility

Job postings will be accepted from:

- Nonprofit organizations, government agencies, and educational institutions
- Local businesses with a demonstrated commitment to equitable employment practices
- Employers offering positions that align with UWHC's mission to improve lives and strengthen our community.

All employers must comply with federal and state employment laws, including anti-discrimination and wage requirements.

Posting Guidelines

Content Requirements: Each job must include the following:

- Job title and organization name
- Clear job description and responsibilities
- Minimum qualifications
- Salary range (strongly encouraged for transparency)
- Work location (in-person, hybrid, or remote)
- Application process and deadline

Job Types Accepted: We accept listings for the following:

- Full-time and part-time employment
- Internships and apprenticeships
- Seasonal and temporary positions

Prohibited Content: We reserve the right to reject or remove any posting that:

- Do not align with UWHC's mission or values
- Promote discriminatory, misleading, or predatory practices
- Are submitted by organizations under legal or ethical scrutiny
