Dear Friend,

I hope this letter finds you and your loved ones healthy and safe, and enjoying some of this fresh, crisp fall air. It's hard for me to believe I am sending you this letter again already- as 2020 has proven to be such a crazy year, that with many of you, the last time we communicated or saw one another was this time last year! These many months in quarantine and apart seem to have just vanished into thin air. I know life has changed for many of us since Covid-19 hit. Some of us have been sick or lost loved ones, or jobs. Kids may be at home instead of school, and many are trying to work from home, if that is possible.

As the holidays approach, we are keenly aware that for our families who have been in need, they are finding themselves in greater financial distress. We are also finding that a whole new group of neighbors who were stable before the pandemic hit, no longer are, and are now requesting our assistance. While we will have to make some small adjustments to our Holiday Hands program to keep our clients, donors, volunteers, and staff safe, we will run it as completely as possible to meet the needs of our community. We hope that you will consider being a donor again this year and supporting our neighbors right here in Hunterdon County who are facing a difficult holiday season.

Last year Holiday Hands provided gifts to **over 2,655** individuals in need. Requested items are things that most of us would take for granted. This year because of Covid concerns, we have limited the client "wish list" more than usual. Donors now might be asked for a new toy for a child, a game or book, a gift card, or even things like diapers, towels, or a set of new sheets.

United Way of Hunterdon County works to match your request for adoptees with families in need and provide you with their "wish list." **This year we are requesting that our donors limit gift donations to \$50 per person.** Every year we see individuals that do not get adopted. If you are able to spend additional funds PLEASE consider adopting an additional family and/or individual.
