Our free workshops teach digital literacy skills that help participants connect to important online resources. From setting up email accounts, to accessing student e-learning platforms, to learning how to navigate online meetings, our skills classes give participants the skills they need to get connected. Classes include:

- Introduction to the internet
- Safe internet browsing tips
- Email setup and navigation
- Genesis (FRSD portal)
- Zoom navigation
- Google Sheets, Docs & Slides tutorials
- ...and more programs to come!

Participants are offered the use of a loaner laptop for the duration of their enrollment, generously donated by ExxonMobil.

Classes are taught by volunteers, school teachers, administrators, and United Way staff. Classes are held at the Volunteer Center in Flemington during weekday, evening hours and on the weekend. Ages 18+ are welcome. Childcare is provided if needed. Spanish translation is provided at every class. There is no cost to participate.
